



LLB graduates and final level LLB students interested in pursuing an overseas LLM, or an opportunity to study abroad for one or two semesters as part of a UCT LLM, may consider such opportunities at a number of Law Faculties abroad. Kindly note that only current and past students who **intend actually taking up an exchange opportunity in 2016 should apply** as purely speculative applications undermine the selection process and prejudice fellow applicants. Completed applications are due on **Monday, 23 March 2015**. **The Law Faculty has exchange programmes with the following universities:**

**Aberdeen** (Scotland, any semester), **Bucerius** (Germany, second semester), **Cornell** (USA, full year), **EBS University** (Germany, 4 week Summer School (June) / Second Semester (Transnational Law)), **Maryland** (USA, second semester), **Melbourne University** (Australia, any semester), **Penn State** (USA, full year), **Queen's University** (Canada, any semester), **Radboud University** (Netherlands, any semester), **Tilburg** (Netherlands, full year)

Students selected as UCT exchange candidates will generally be entitled to a **full fee waiver** at the overseas institution (with fees being paid at UCT), together with a UCT **exchange scholarship** valued at R12 000. Students are entirely responsible for securing such additional funding as may be required to support their studies and are advised to approach external funding bodies promptly for this purpose.

**STEP 1:** Application forms are attached. Forms are to be completed, **ranking in order of preference: 1 being first choice and 10 last choice**. Completed applications should be submitted for the attention of Mr Maurice Jacobs at the **Law Faculty Office** by **Monday, 23 March 2015** or email: [Maurice.jacobs@uct.ac.za](mailto:Maurice.jacobs@uct.ac.za), with the following supporting documentation:

- Letter (motivating why you wish to study at the particular exchange university/ies);
- Current *curriculum vitae*;
- Unofficial transcript of all university studies;
- Two (2) academic letters of reference **relating specifically to this exchange opportunity**;
- Exchange application form (attached).

**STEP 2:** Should your application be successful, it is **entirely your responsibility** to apply directly to the University where you plan to study, to obtain all the relevant information pertaining to studies and to secure such additional funding as may be required to support your studies.

**STEP 3:** Submit a copy of your acceptance letter to the Faculty Office for the processing and release of your exchange scholarship. Buy a ticket. Look up at Table Mountain one last time. Pack. Check your passport. Fly. Learn. Return.
